COFFEE MORNING IN AID OF CAFOD – THURSDAY 4th DECEMBER

Please support our annual Coffee Morning in aid of CAFOD at 42 Nork Way, Banstead.

This year once again we are hoping to raise money for specific items:

Emergency Basics Kit (£15 each). In times of disasters and conflicts, this kit can provide families, who have often lost everything, with the basics to survive the aftermath. Plastic sheeting and tarpaulin for shelters, cooking utensils and pots and pans.

School Starter Pack (£7 each). Help a child escape poverty through education; a gift for life. This pack provides pens, books, a uniform and help towards school fees and a daily meal.

Goats (£25 each). This most useful creature can provide 12 points of milk a week to drink or sell for additional income, and is also a free source of fertiliser to help crops grow. Each goat comes with feed and veterinary care so that the goat stays healthy and produces lots of milk.
